We will meet at Snitz Creek at Indiantown at 9:30 am for breakfast and leave as soon as everyone is finished eating. Upon arrival at Snitz Creek please make sure to have a full tank of gas and an empty bladder. There will be an ice cream stop on the way, close to Wellsboro. There are several options for dinner in Wellsboro and it is suggested that people go to the venue that sounds best to them. If time and weather permit, Ed will take the group to the PA Lumber Museum, cost is \$8.00, (\$7.00 for seniors), after check in at the motel. People are on their own for breakfast on Sunday August 6th, the Wellsboro Diner is just down the street – walking distance. – Ed will be leaving around 10am that morning to head back home. A visit to one or both sides of the Canyon is possible depending on weather, time and interest. There will be a lunch stop on the way home. 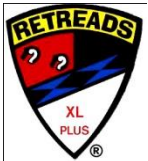
