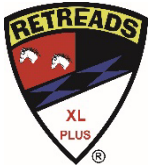

THE RETREADS CREST

The Name RETREADS is obvious. We have reached an age where a retread has become necessary!

The Shape of the Retreads crest was taken from a US Navy award presented for that which is considered to be the best! *THE GOLD FIELD* at the top is to denote those Golden years over forty. *THE FIELD OF RED* which contains the rampant stallion heads is for the valor and blood that we have shed. *THE STALLIONS* who appear so proud, represent the strength and stamina of the Retreads. Used as a pair, they indicate that we work together as a team. *THE BAR SINISTER* which slants upward from left to right across the field signifies the **BLACK** and **BLUE** marks that we all acquired while we were learning to ride. *THE FIELD OF WHITE* symbolizes our purity of mind and thoughts, and the color of our face in the first tight squeeze. *THE RED ROMAN NUMERALS XL "PLUS"* designates our age of over forty... and as everyone knows, life really does begin at forty! *THE BLUE OVERBAR* above the field of gold is reserved to designate the state or province in which the wearer resides.



The Chief is a field of **GOLD** representing the Golden years, with the name **RETREADS** thereon. 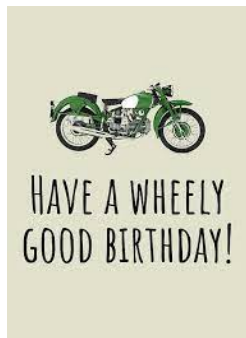

Safety Tip by Blain H

With spring around the corner it's time to start thinking about our group riding skills. Depending who you ask group riding is safer or group riding is more dangerous. Group riding crashes that occur without the influence of other highway users is usually caused by operator error



within the group of motorcycles. Some examples include riding side by side, following too closely and inattentive riders. I have seen riders distracted by just waving to bikes going the opposite direction. When the rider looked to see if they wave back the group was stopped to make a left turn and the inattentive rider crashed into other bikes. When riding in a group you must have you're "A" game on, there is more people and more shiny heavy metal things (Motorcycles) near you then when it's just you sightseeing down the road chasing your favorite ice cream cone. 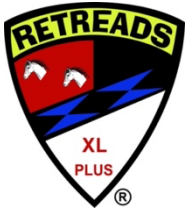
