### Safety Tip

It's the end of Summer and this seems like an odd time to talk about dehydration, but it is important to stay hydrated year round. Yes, everybody knows during the summer when it is hot out to stay hydrated (drink water), because you are sweating. Carrying water at all times is important, not only during the summer but year round. Even in the chilly to cold seasons your body still needs to stay hydrated. Imagine riding down the road in a short sleeve shirt with the wind blowing on you, think of yourself as a wet towel blowing in the wind. In time you will become dry. Or during the winter when you are wearing layers of clothing for warmth, your body sweats (whether you realize it or not), so in both cases your body is losing water. Other things to take into consideration is that coffee and soda both dehydrate your body. Drink them in moderation. I could also mention alcohol. Not that we will be drinking and driving but a few drinks the night before put you at risk for dehydration.
